Assessment Fee Payment Options

Starting November 1, 2022, The Woodlands Condominium will utilize Alliance Association Bank (AAB) for Monthly Assessment Payments. AAB specializes in banking for Homeowners Associations and Condominiums. This allows you as the homeowner a wide range of options for making Homeowners Association assessment payments. All payments are made directly with the bank to provided efficient and secure service. If you are signed up through our office for automatic payments, we will no longer process those after your October payment. We will no longer accept payments in our office. If you own multiple units, you must send in separate payments for each unit.

- 1) Online Options: (See detailed instructions #1 if you would like to use any of these options.)
- a) <u>Pay by Direct Debit online</u>: Homeowners can have assessments taken directly out of their accounts each month, for free. Since it's automatic, homeowners won't have to worry about remembering to make payments.
- b) <u>Pay by eCheck online</u>: Homeowners can make a one-time or reoccurring automatic assessment payment with just a few clicks. Payments made with eCheck will take up to four days to process.
- c) <u>Pay by Credit Card online</u>: AAB's secure, convenient HOA assessment payment service accepts Visa[®], MasterCard[®], American Express[®] and Discover[®] Card, with minimal fees. Payments made by credit card may take up to five days to process.
- 2) <u>Pay by Mail:</u> (See detailed instructions #2 if you would like to use this option.) Homeowners can write checks for assessment fees and mail them to AAB's Lockbox center, where they will be quickly processed and deposited.
- Pay by Automatic Bill Pay with Your Personal Financial Institution: (See detailed instructions #3 if you would like to use this option.) Homeowners can set up automatic payments with their personal financial institution.

2. Payments by Mail with a Check:

If you would like to use the US Postal Service, checks for the Association fee must be payable to **The Woodlands Condominium**. For prompt and accurate processing, please be sure to **include your Association ID and your Account Number on the check on the memo line**. For example, Unit 001 would use woodld -001WOODL on the memo line.

3. Payments with your personal financial institution:

If you utilize your personal financial institutions online bill pay system, please do the following:

- 1. Create a new payee for your payments using the mailing address listed below.
- When asked for your payee account number, please enter your Association I.D and your Account Number. For example, Unit 1 would use the account number 001WOODL, and the payee account number would be woodid -001WOODL.
